Unlimited Transfer Request

This note explains the player's rights and responsibilities when planning to transfer from one country to the national association of another country. It should be read carefully and must be signed by the player before the International Transfer can be processed and must be uploaded to the online transfer system when requesting the transfer.

The choices the player has to make:

1. The player has the option to choose the basis on which they are transferred – limited or unlimited and this would be indicated in the transfer request made in the Online Transfer System
 - 1.1 A limited transfer means that the player transfers temporarily to a specific club under the jurisdiction of the "new" National Association but automatically returns to the former Member National Association when the transfer expires. During the period of the temporary transfer they may still call upon their former Member National Association for support. A limited transfer cannot be limited to less than the p
